ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED

Dress Code:

Students shall wear appropriate clothing and are encouraged to dress appropriately for the season. The following are examples of clothing and cosmetic items that are **not acceptable** and are **not permitted**.

(This is not an all-inclusive list)

1. Bare midriff garments, tank tops/tees or low-cut tops
2. Halter or tube tops
3. Short shirts and mini skirts
4. See-through or other revealing clothing
5. Hats while in the building
6. Clothing showing sex, violence, profanity, drugs, alcohol, demonic themes, occult themes or gang themes
7. Extremely tight-fitting clothing
8. Pants hanging excessively below the waist
9. Combs, picks or rollers in the hair
10. Coats worn in the building
11. Oversize earrings
12. Nose or other body piercing jewelry
13. Make-up
14. Hair dye or coloring
